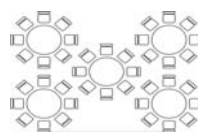

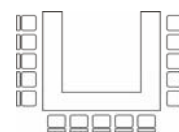

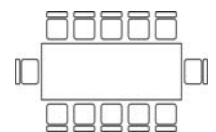

## **OTHER INFORMATION – TRAVEL GUIDE**

Chengdu is one of the first historic and cultural cities of China designated by the State Council. There are 172 important cultural landscapes, especially ErWang Temple, the Temple of Marquis Wu, Dufu Thatched Cottage, and Dujiangyan Irrigation System; and 19 key cultural relics under the state-level and province-level protection. Chengdu has a complex topography characterized by the scenes of mountains, caves, and waters, as well as the gorgeous animals and plants, and nature fantasy. Moreover, Chengdu is located at the joint point of all-nation tourist circle and the Sichuan tourist circle which are formed by the connection of Jianmen Gate and Shudao Path, Jiuzhaigou Valley, Chengdu, Ermei Mountain, Three Gorges, etc. Chengdu is also the main access to Tibet from the hinterland.

## **OTHER INFORMATION – HISTORY**

Chengdu has emerged to be one of the premier cities in China. History of Chengdu dates back to the early fourth century BC. This was when the king 9<sup>th</sup> Kaiming of Shu transferred his capital from Pixian to the current location of Chengdu. History suggests that the king was influenced by the act of King Tai of Zhou who shifted his capital. It is said that – “it took a year to become a town; it took 2 years to become a capital”. Keeping this in mind, the city was given the name “Cheng Du”, meaning to “become” (Cheng) a “capital” (Du). But many of the recent studies differ on the reason behind shifting of the capital. In 316 BC, Shu was conquered by the State of Qin. Qin general Zhang Yi, who was against this conquest, founded a new city. This was the beginning of today's Chengdu. When the Han Dynasty came to power, the city was renamed Yizhou. Then, through the passage of time, came the era of Three Kingdoms Liu Bei. This brought about the fall of Western Han Dynasty. The Southwest kingdom of Shu-Han was established and the city of Chengdu was made its capital. History of Chengdu is noted for a significant incident. During the rulings of the Northern Song Dynasty at around 960A.D, Chengdu saw the birth of paper currency. As the sun of the Song Dynasty and Ming Dynasty was about to set, two rebel leaders had set up their capitals here. The capitals were known as Dàshu and Dàxi respectively. It was during the Second World War when things took a sharp turn for Chengdu. In order to escape the hands of Japanese invasion, the Chinese Nationalist government fled to Sichuan Province. This created an influx of academics, businessmen, traders and workers to the city of Chengdu. This eventually resulted in setting up of cultural institutions and important industries in the region. At present, Chengdu is a premier industrial base in China.

## **OTHER INFORMATION – CULTURES**

Chengdu is a city that has Shu customs and south-western customs. Chuan local opera and Sichuan folk art forms are the popular local opera. Chengdu holds some festivals every year, such as the Lantern Festival in the Lunar New Year, the Flower Festival in February, Qingming Festival of Dujiang Dam in March, the Cassia-blossom Festival of Xindu in August, the Mum Festival in October and so on. At that time, people enjoy the sight of the lantern, appreciate the flowers, watch the art shows and taste the delicious food. There are some handicrafts in Chengdu and all of them have a long history and are well known both in China and abroad. They are Shu brocade, Shu embroidery, lacquer ware and bamboo-shell china. Among them, Shu brocade has 2000 years' history, and it is one of the four famous brocades in China. Shu embroidery has 1600 years' history, it is also one of the four famous embroideries in China. And lacquer ware has more than 2000 years' history. Chuan flavour and Chengdu snacks are famous in the world. In China, there are four flavours: Jing, Su, Chuan and Yue. And Chuan flavour is one of them. The delicious Chengdu snacks are Sichuan noodles with peppery sauce, fresh meat ravioli, bell dumpling, Sichuan glutinous rice balls, pearl balls of glutinous rice and fried lung.

## OTHER INFORMATION – GEOGRAPHICAL

Chengdu is sub-provincial city in the eastern part of Liaoning Province of China. The city of Chengdu in Northeast China is one of the important cities in the nation. The geographical co-ordinates of Shanghai are 35° N and 105° E. The city forms a part of Eastern Asia. The city is bordered by South China Sea, Yellow Sea, Korea Bay and the East China Sea. The East China Sea is a part of the Pacific Ocean. Chengdu, the capital of Sichuan Province of south-west China, is a sub-provincial city. Chengdu lies in the centre of the fertile Chengdu Plain. The entire city is spread across a surface area of 12.3 thousand square kilometers or 4749 square miles. The geography of Chengdu is consisted of five administrative districts and twelve counties. Agricultural activities in Chengdu have earned it the title of 'Land of Milk and Honey'. The total land area of the city of Chengdu is 12,390 square kilometers. The water bodies are spread over an area of about 270,550 square kilometers. The city has a stretching coastline of 598 kilometers.

## OTHER INFORMATION – CLIMATE

Chengdu features subtropical humid monsoon climate, the weather is relatively moderate with plenty of rainfall, and distinctive four seasons with an annual average temperature of 15.2°C -16.6°C. One of the obvious characteristics of Chengdu's climate is mostly foggy weather, there is a folk saying of "dog of Shu barking at the sun" telling that the dog barks on seeing the sun, which describes the foggy weather visually. Another outstanding feature of the climate is the moist air, so summer in Chengdu is hot and humid. The atmosphere is wonderful during the springs and summers. The nature wears a serene look. This is when the blossoming of rape-seeds décor the nature with a riot of colours. The landscapes of Chengdu make travel in Chengdu all the more interesting and enjoyable.



## OTHER INFORMATION – WHAT TO SEE

The giant pandas are not only a Chinese national treasure but are also beloved by people the world over. They are found only in Sichuan, Shaanxi and Gansu provinces. In total there are fewer than 1000, of which 80% are distributed within the territory of Sichuan province. Therefore, when visitors from home and abroad come to Chengdu, Sichuan Province one of their main objectives will be to see the giant pandas for themselves. Located just 10km (6 miles) away from downtown Chengdu, the Chengdu Panda Breeding Research Center has been created and imitated the pandas' natural habitat in order that they might have the best possible environment for rearing and breeding. The Center cares also for other rare and endangered wild animals. The Research Center covers an area of 92 acres, 96% of which is verdure. Giant pandas, lesser pandas, black-necked cranes, white storks as well as over 20 species of rare animals are fed and bred there throughout the year. Verdant bamboo, bright flowers, fresh air, a natural hill scene and a beautiful artificial view are merged ingeniously at the base.
